The all-new 2015 Ford Edge confidently asserts its presence with a striking new stance. Luxurious accommodations for five are paired with a smoother, quieter ride and precise handling. Plus, innovative technologies help to enhance its prowess – and yours. The standard 2.0-litre EcoBoost® turbocharged engine allows Edge to be responsive, yet economical. Edge is also watching out for you and yours: Curve Control can reduce vehicle speed by up to 16 km/h if it senses you're taking a curve too fast, and optional inflatable safety belts keep rear and front passengers secure.

1. ENHANCED ACTIVE PARK ASSIST

Using 12 ultrasonic sensors, Edge can identify a suitable parallel parking space, calculate the trajectory, and automatically steer the car into the space. All the driver needs to do is operate the accelerator and brake pedals. This vehicle also has Park Out Assist to help steer you out of a tight parallel parking space, while Side Parking Sensor watches your back, front and sides – warning you when you come close to an object.

2. MAKE AN INFORMED APPROACH

At slow speeds, Edge helps you see around corners, down alleys and even while you're pulling out of parking spots, thanks to the available 180° camera tucked into the grille. Just press a button on the instrument panel to engage, and get a full-colour look at what's happening in front and to the front sides of your vehicle.

3. LANE-KEEPING SYSTEM

This innovative technology consists of three elements to help alert a driver to maintain proper lane position. Using a small forward-facing camera behind the inside rearview mirror, the system “looks” down the road, monitoring lane markings to ensure the vehicle is on course. The system will alert the driver if the vehicle wanders or if it senses that the driver is drowsy, and can also apply light steering pressure to guide the vehicle back into its lane.

4. BLIND SPOT INFORMATION SYSTEM

Blind Spot Information System (BLIS®) with Cross-Traffic Alert uses sensors able to detect traffic in a driver's blind spot, providing a visual warning if vehicles are detected. Cross-Traffic Alert audibly warns the driver of vehicles approaching from either side when backing out of a parking space with obstructed views.

5. 12-SPEAKER SONY SOUND SYSTEM

Edge's 390-watt Sony Audio System is made up of 12 high-quality speakers with Dolby® Surround Sound technology, plus one subwoofer. Edge's media hub also features two USB ports, audio/video input jacks and SD card reader, so you can be charged and ready to play at all times.

6. ALL-CLIMATE COMFORT

Edge keeps passengers comfortable at all times with optional heated rear seats, plus heated and cooled front seats. Sound insulation improvements and quieter engines, paired with optional Vista Roof® let the outside in, but only at your request.

7. STAYING CONNECTED

Edge is packed with technology to keep you connected, allowing you to keep your eyes on the road and your hands on the wheel. It comes with SYNC® with MyFord Touch® allowing drivers to interact through voice control, a touch screen tap or a conventional button. You can even ask your car for restaurant suggestions by saying “I'm hungry.” When paired with SYNC®, “Do Not Disturb” blocks incoming phone calls or text messages. Calls are diverted to voicemail and text messages are saved on the device for later viewing. Drivers can still make voice-activated outgoing calls, and SYNC 911 Assist® is always on in case of emergency.
